The event also celebrated the enormous progress the Foundation has achieved with the help of its supporters.

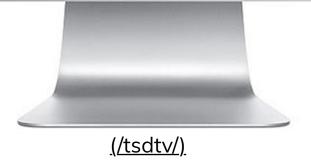
